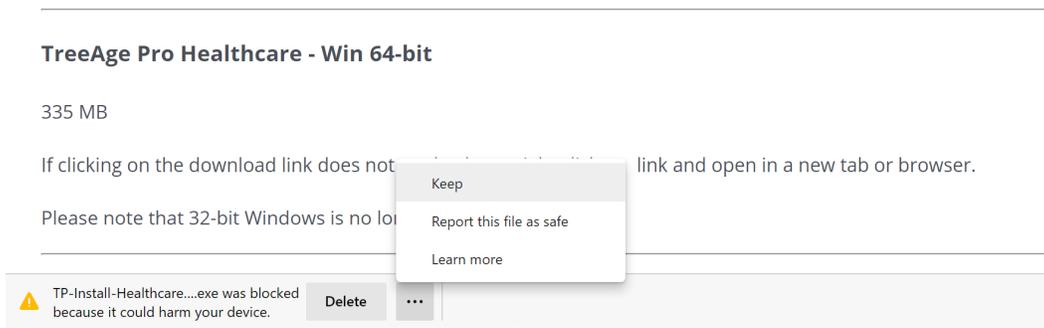


Issues Installing TreeAge Pro on Windows 10

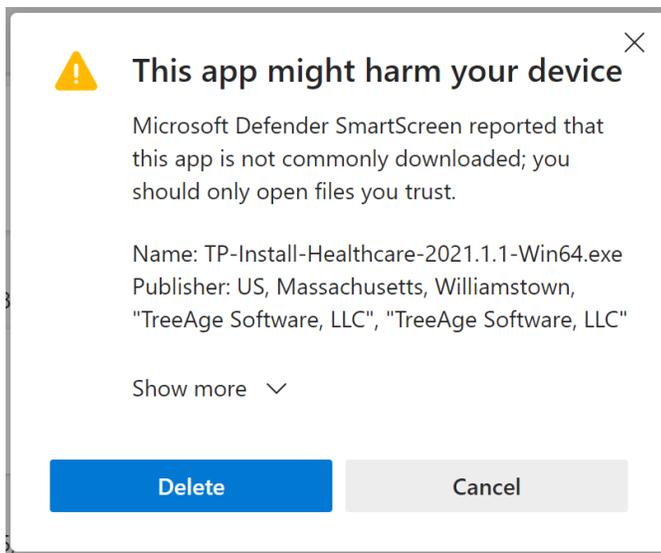
Recent updates to Windows 10 have made installing software more difficult. This document highlights some common issues installing TreeAge Pro.

Downloading

- Issue: Microsoft Edge and other browsers may issue a warning when you download the TreeAge Pro installer.
- Solution: Click the button with three dots then choose Keep from the context menu.



- Issue: You may then see a warning about the app harming your device.

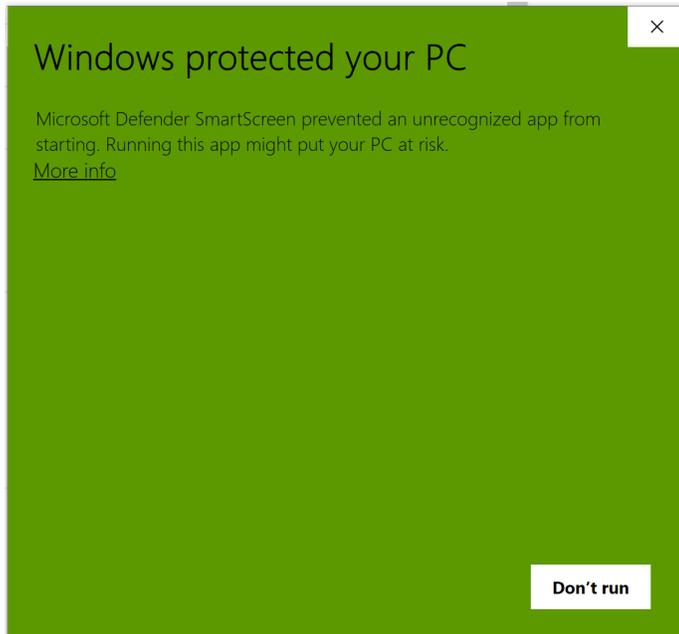


- Solution: Click Show more then click Keep Anyway.

Issues Installing TreeAge Pro on Windows 10

Installing

- Issue: When you double-click on the installer, you may receive another warning that Windows has “protected your PC”.



- Solution:
 - Click More Info.
 - Click Run Anyway.
 - If you see a User Account Control warning, click Yes.
 - Proceed through the installer instructions.
- Issue: On some computers controlled by an organization, installation may require administrator rights.
- Solution: Right-click on the installer then choose Run as Administrator from the context menu.
